Support Maryland Swimming by Buying Your License Plate Today!

1. Where does the Money Go?

- \$15 from the sale of each \$40 license plate will be used to support Maryland Swimming, Inc. The remaining \$25 goes to the Motor Vehicle Administration.

2. Who can Participate?

- Any Maryland resident who is a friend of Maryland Swimming can buy a license plate.
- No need to wait until your current license plate expires. Renewals will be due the same month/year as usual for your vehicle.
- Available for passenger cars, multi-purpose vehicles and trucks up to 3/4 ton.

3. How do you buy your license plate?

- To receive an "MVA Application/Certification for Organization Plates" application, send a self-addressed, stamped envelop to:

- Complete the "MVA Application/Certification for Organization Plates" application that you receive back in the mail. You need to fill in information for your vehicle, taken from your registration card. Please be sure to fill in the phone number information and sign the form.

- The name of the organization is Maryland Swimming, Inc. Bridget is the Authorized Representative and will sign your completed form upon receipt.

- The fee is \$40 per vehicle. ***Make your check payable to Maryland Swimming, Plate Program.***

- Mail your completed application, a copy of your vehicle registration card and your check to Bridget Vaché. ***Do not send the application to the Motor Vehicle Administration.***

4. After your application has been processed

- the MVA will issue your new license plates along with a new registration card and a new expiration sticker. These will come directly to your address. Return your old license plates to the MVA. Please allow up to ten weeks for this process.
